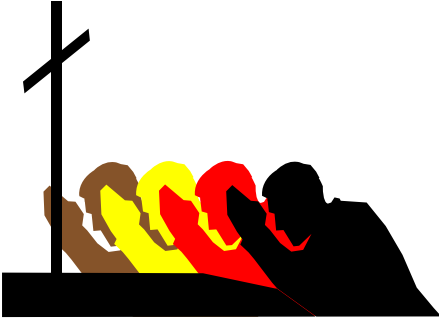
Today's Special Speaker
