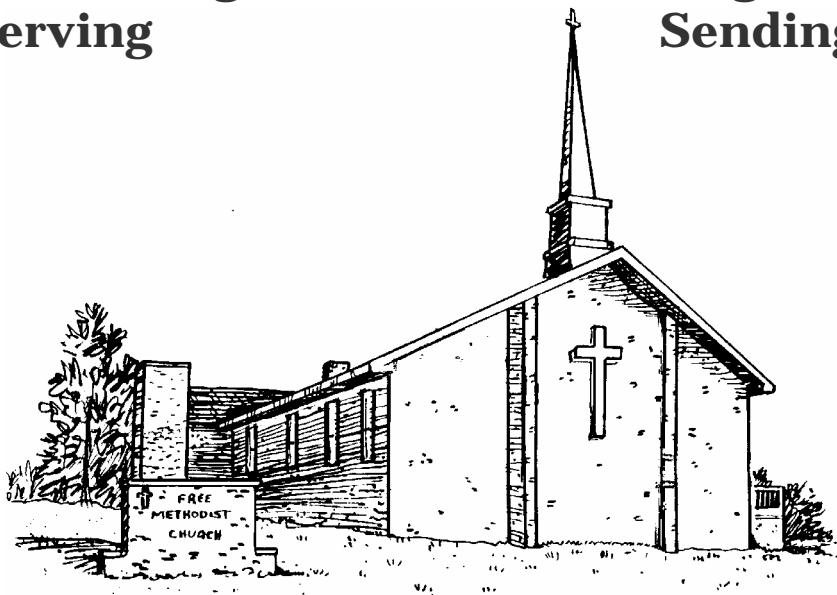

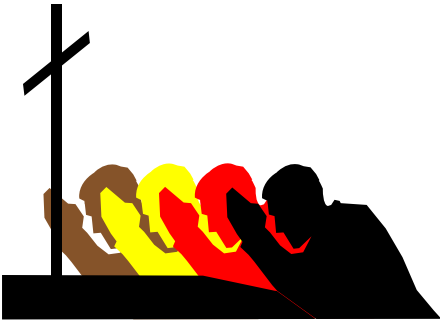

Missing – One Parking Lot Line Painter Machine

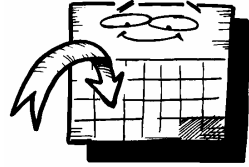
We need to paint new lines on our parking lot. We found the paint but not the machine. If you have seen it tucked away around the church somewhere or perhaps borrowed it, please let us know.
