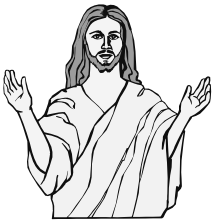

SERVICE OF PRAYER FOR THE HEALING OF HUMAN HURTS

Each of us carries concerns for friends, or loved ones. Many of us have burdens of our own which often are too heavy to bear. At times there are broken places in our body, mind, or spirit which only Christ can heal.

Our risen Lord stands among His people in a service such as this, welcoming you to come with your burden and with your hurt, to let Him touch you with His healing love.

As you come to the altar to share your need with God, your Christian friends will be praying for you.

We invite each of you to become a part of a caring, praying, trusting congregation in these moments. During this time let the creative work of the Holy Spirit bring you to a new level of wholeness in Christ. It may also be a moment when you realize in a deeper way that Christ is carrying the heaviest part of your burden for yourself or someone else.

James 5:14-15

Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord. ¹⁵And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven.

Matthew 15:30 "Great crowds came to him, bringing the lame, the blind, the crippled, the mute and many others, and laid them at his feet; and he healed them."

Mark 6:56 "And wherever he went--into villages, towns or countryside--they placed the sick in the marketplaces. They begged him to let them touch even the edge of his cloak, and all who touched him were healed."

Luke 4:40 "When the sun was setting, the people brought to Jesus all who had various kinds of sickness, and laying his hands on each one, he healed them."

Luke 8:47-48 "Then the woman, seeing that she could not go unnoticed, came trembling and fell at his feet. In the presence of all the people, she told why she had touched him and how she had been instantly healed. ⁴⁸Then he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace."

Acts 4:9-10 "If we are being called to account today for an act of kindness shown to a cripple and are asked how he was healed, ¹⁰then know this, you and all the people of Israel: It is by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified but whom God raised from the dead, that this man stands before you healed."

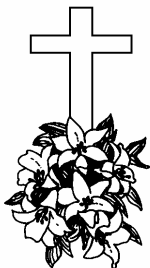

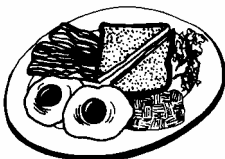
