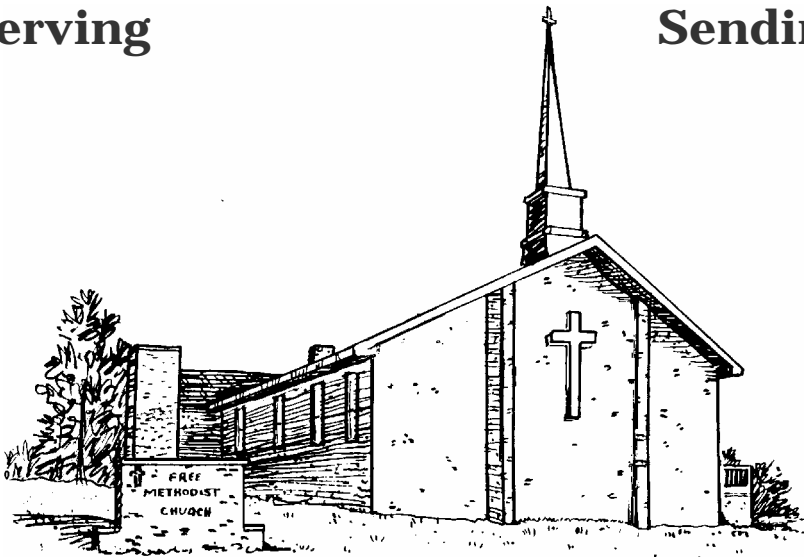

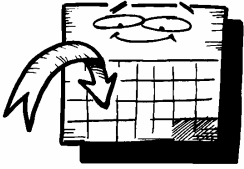

CHRISTIAN WAYS TO REDUCE STRESS

An Angel says, "Never borrow from the future. If you worry about what may happen tomorrow and it doesn't happen, you have worried in vain. Even if it does happen, you have to worry twice." "If God is for us, who can be against us?" (Romans 8:31)

1. Pray
2. Go to bed on time. Get up on time so you can start the day unrushed.
3. Say No to projects that won't fit into your time schedule, or that will compromise your mental health.
4. Delegate tasks to capable others.
5. Simplify and unclutter your life. Less is more.
6. Allow extra time to do things and to get to places. Slow Down!
7. Pace yourself. Spread out big changes and difficult projects over time; don't lump the hard things all together.
8. Take one day at a time.
9. Separate worries from concerns .. If a situation is a concern, find out what God would have you do and let go of the anxiety . If you can't do anything about a situation, forget it.
10. Live within your budget.
11. Have backups; an extra car key and house key, extra stamps, etc.
12. K.M.S. (Keep Mouth Shut). This single piece of advice can prevent an enormous amount of trouble.
13. Do something for the Kid in You everyday.
14. Carry a Bible with you to read while waiting in line.
15. Get enough rest and Eat right.
- 16 Get organized so everything has its place.
17. Listen to a tape while driving that will improve your quality of life.
18. Write down thoughts and inspirations.
19. Every day, find time to be alone.
20. Having problems? Talk to God on the spot. Nip small problems in the bud. Don't wait until it's time to go to bed to pray.
21. Make friends with Godly people.
22. Keep a folder of favorite scriptures on hand.
23. Remember that the shortest bridge between despair and hope is often a good "Thank you Jesus .."
24. Laugh. Laugh some more!
25. Take your work seriously, but not yourself at all.
26. Develop a forgiving attitude (most people do the best they can).
27. Be kind to unkind people (they probably need it the most).
28. Sit on your ego. Talk less; listen more.
29. Remind yourself you are not the general manager of the universe.
