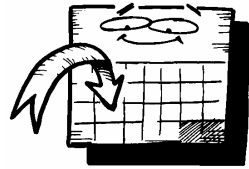

The waiting is finally over... Joey's scans are clean- crystal clear- and he is ready to begin 3F8 on Tuesday. We are a bit surprised, and completely overwhelmed by the amazing news. I received a call from the team at Sloan this evening and was told that we need to be in New York on Tuesday morning to begin a month long treatment plan that involves the 3F8 antibody therapy and intensive radiation, as well as the start of Accutane. It seems

the drugs; in combination with radiation have good success at keeping the cancer from recurring. The good news has left us scrambling a bit, trying to decide what would be the best way of getting through the next month in NY- We had anticipated a 6<sup>th</sup> round of chemo, which would have taken us to mid-June when Olivia would be finished with school... since that is not the case we are trying to figure out plans, and even now in the midst of the confusion and anxiousness I know that the Lord has hand in *all* of this situation and that it will work out. We just have to trust Him.

Please keep us in your prayers as we begin this next phase of Joey's treatment. We know that nothing short of a miracle has occurred in Joey- considering how far he has come since receiving the diagnosis in December leaves me in awe of the power that is unharnessed when faithful people pray. We are hopeful that 3F8 will be successful at keeping the cancer from returning and that we will be telling the story of Joey's amazing recovery for many years to come... Thanks for being a part of this journey... Maggie
