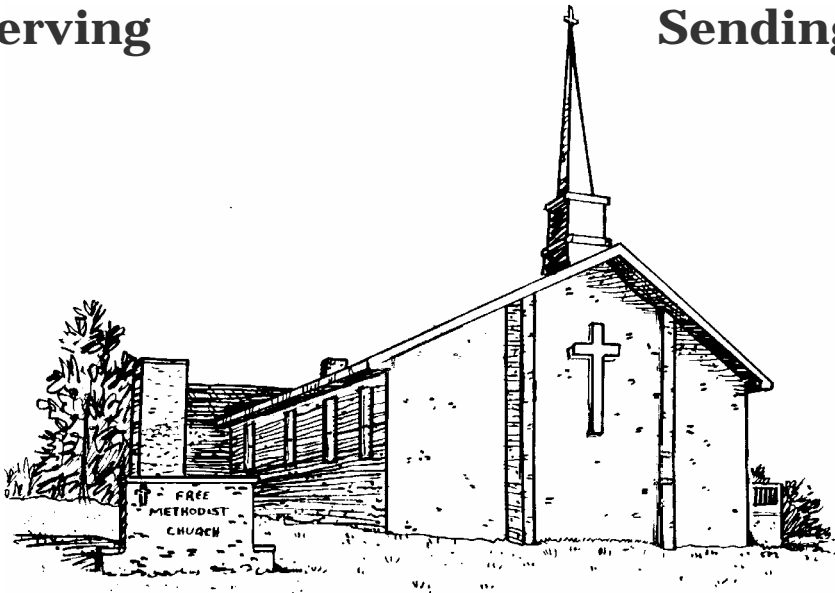

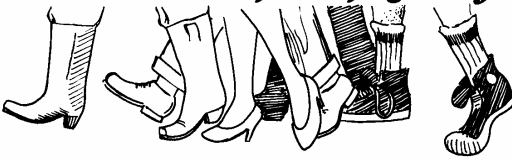

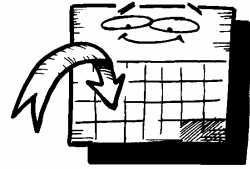

Do You Need Another Attorney?
