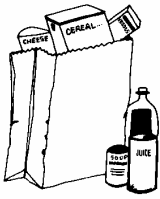

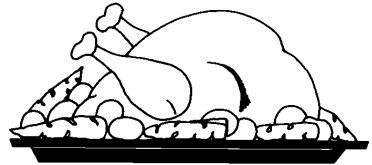


# Annual Food Drive To Benefit Washington Christian Outreach

## Five Ways You Can Help

1. Bring in a food donation of non-perishable items between now and December 6<sup>th</sup> and drop it off in the bin in the Narthex. When you get your groceries each week, pick up a little extra for Christian Outreach. Pick up a list from back table of what items are especially needed.

**Praise Note – Prayers are answered in the Ukraine**

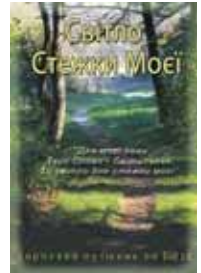


A new light shines in Ukraine! We now have an officially registered mission! Its name is “Mayak Nadii” which means Beacon of Hope. The fact that we are registered allows us the freedom to carry out a multitude of religious activities anywhere in Ukraine. Many of you know how long we have waited and prayed for this day. Many

of you have prayed for the same.

**THANK YOU! REJOICE WITH US! GOD BE PRAISED!**

One of our mission's first projects is the writing and printing of a simple guide to the Bible. The name on the cover (pictured) means “A Light for my Path”. Ukrainian Bibles do not contain a concordance or additional information about the Bible so most people have no idea where to find answers to their questions. This booklet will be the first of its kind in Ukraine.
