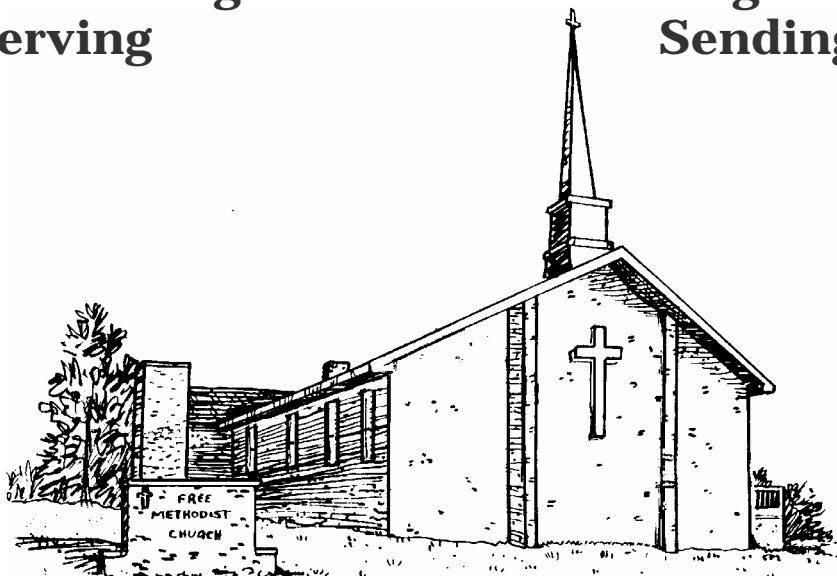

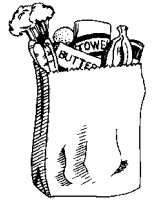

Goodbye Kiev, hello again

Rivne!

It's hard to believe it has been four years since I made the move to the capital city—what I call the New York, D.C., and Hollywood of Ukraine all wrapped into one! Near the end of September, during a conversation with my team in Rivne, it became clear that now was the time to re-join them locally and work together to grow the Kingdom there. It will be hard to leave, but I know it is a change that God will bless!



Kingdom-Building Conference

Shortly after I got back to Ukraine, we attended a conference just outside the city in a peaceful forest setting with about 50-60 other believers from all over the

former Soviet Union. The conference was for those who are working in simple churches or experiencing more participatory and Christ-centered forms of church multiplication.

It was greatly encouraging to see and hear from these brothers and sisters in Christ, and be reminded that a movement of growth, multiplication, etc – is just that, a movement of God. One woman gave her story of working in inland Crimea and said very honestly that if you want to make disciples, you have to be willing to lay down your life.'
